Dr P Smythe-Wood's Irish Newspaper Index
German Connections

The late Dr Patrick Smythe-Wood presented a large collection of card indexes to the IGRS Library, reflecting his various interests, - the Irish in Canada, Ulster families, Prison Officers etc. This small index covers German families with Irish connections. The index includes abstracts from various Irish Newspapers, mainly Ulster, including the Belfast Newsletter. Abstracts are included for all papers, excluding any entries in the Belfast Newsletter prior to 1801, as these are fully available online. Newspapers after 1864 are also almost always omitted.

BAEDECKER: [Belfast Newsletter, 23 Jun 1862, & Ballymena Observer, 28th Jun 1862] June 17 at Trinity Church, Weston-super-Mare, by the Rev W Hunt, Incumbent, F W Baedecker Esq, of Witten, Westphalia, Prussia, to Anne Jane, widow of Captain Alex H Ormsby, of Gilford, county Down & daughter of the late Captain Leigh Lye, Bath.

BRUNN: [Belfast Newsletter, 19 Dec 1857] December 15 in Clonmel, Julius W Brunn Esq, of Hamburg, to Charlotte E, third daughter of the late Joseph Going Esq of Clonmel.

BRUTZER: [Downpatrick Recorder, 3 Jun 1843] On the 27th ult at the British Embassy, Brussels, by the Rev Edward Kent, Rector of Annahilt, county Down, Henry W Brutzer, Professor of Political Economy, Stuttgart, to Maria Louisa, second daughter of the late Benjamin Thomas Esq of Dublin.

DE HARLING: [The Public Ledger & Daily Advertiser, 2 Oct 1810] September 11th at Lismore, George Theodore de Harling, Lieutenant in the 2nd King's German Legion, to Susan, youngest daughter of the late John Hewetson of Suirville, county of Kilkenny.

DILGER: [Belfast Newsletter, 16 May 1860] May 4 at Ballymena, Mr Charles Dilger, a native of Neustadt in the Grand Duchy of Baden.

FAHR: [Belfast Newsletter, 11 Dec 1863] December 9 at Lurgan, by the Rev S C Nelson, Ernest Augustus Fahr Esq, son of Henry Augustus Fahr Esq, Revisor of Finance, Brunswick, to Dora, eldest daughter of R S Hannay Esq, MD, Lurgan.

KAMCKE: [Belfast Newsletter, 5 Aug 1859, & Ballymena Observer, 13th Aug 1859] August 3 in Holywood Church, by the Rev J C Flood, AM, Louis Alexander Kamcke Esq, of Dantzig, to Louisa Parker, eldest daughter of the late James M'Cutcheon Esq of Holywood.

LOEWENTHAL: [Belfast Newsletter, 10 Jul 1861] July 10 at Malone Presbyterian Church, by the Rev Dr Morgan, Julius Loewenthal of Ludingsalust, Germany, to Jane, youngest daughter of the late William M'Culla, Belfast.

MACHYERBACH: [Otago Daily Times, 5 Apr 1869] On the 3rd April at the residence of the bride, George Street, by the Rev Father Morean, August James de Carter, youngest son of Septimus Yager Machyerbach, Prussia, to Bridget, youngest daughter of Patrick O'Donoghue Cox, county Derry, Ireland.

MENDELSON: [Belfast Newsletter, 17 Nov 1859] November 16 at Brooklyn, Holywood (the residence of the father of the bride) by the Rev Julius Sandheim of Dublin, M R Mendelsohn Esq of Hamburg, to Malvina, eldest daughter of Daniel Joseph Jaffe Esq.

OBERNDORFF: [Ballymena Observer, 10 Sep 1859] August 23rd at Douglas, Isle of Man, Count Alfred Oberndorff, eldest son of the Count of Oberndorff, Regendorff etc, Bavaria, to Amelia Maria, widow of the late Lesley Alexander Esq, FP, & DL, of the county of Londonderry, & daughter of the late Colonel Thomas Bates.

ORMSBY: see BAEDECKER

PFEILITZER: [Belfast Newsletter, 15 Jul 1853] At his residence in London, having attained the advanced age of 102 years, Colonel the Baron Pfeilitzer, who formerly served in the Prussian service & subsequently in the English army under the Duke of York. He was father-in-law to the present resident magistrate of County Monaghan, C Hunt Esq.

REUTER: [Belfast Newsletter, 11 Dec 1863] December 9 at the Presbyterian Meeting House, Portadown, by the Rev William Henry Charles Theodore Reuter, Hanover, Germany, to Mary, third daughter of the late William M'Dowell Esq, Rocks, Loughall.

SEISS: [Northern Whig, 14 Jun 1851] On the 10th instant at Mullabrack, by the Rev J B Frith, James Wann Esq of Cavan, to Amanda Wilhelmina Antoinette, second daughter of Augustus Seiss Esq, Coasfield, Westphalia.

THOMAS: see BRUTZER

YEAGER: [Otago Daily Times, 9 Apr 1869] On the 3rd April at St Joseph's Church, Dunedin, by the Rev Father Moreau, August, youngest son of Gottfried Yeager, Germany, to Bridget, second daughter of Robert Michael Cox, Asdie, County Kerry, Ireland.
