"I was a Capt. in Col. Pursell's Regt. of Horse in James II's Army in Ireland, and at the surrender of Limerick I joined the English Army. I fitted out my own troop at a cost of £300 and was ordered to join Col. John Rice's Regt. at Clonmel. Brig. Villars thereupon disbanded the Regt. and seized the horses and arms. Col. John Rice obtained an indemnity of £11,420 - 17 - 6 but only gave each Capt. £40 instead of £1700. I came a year and three quarters ago to England from my wife and three young children in order to try and get the money from Col. Rice which I have so far failed to do."
